What is a Long Range Transportation Plan?

Metro's Long Range Transportation Plan (LRTP) takes a look ahead about 20-25 years down the road to determine what the county's residents will need in terms of transportation options to get around the county. [from Metro website]

The Draft 2009 LRTP will update changes that have occurred since the 2001 LRTP, including growth patterns, the latest technical assumptions, climate change issues, and the substantial shortage of transportation funding in today's environment. It will also make recommendations on transportation projects that can be implemented through 2030, and other projects that could be funded if new revenue sources become available.

Approval of an updated Long Range Transportation Plan (last updated 2001) is necessary for any Measure R project to be eligible for even a small amount of federal funding. Some, like the Wilshire Subway and the Regional Connector, will require a significant amount of federal funding.
